2. Principal's Report - T. Comish

- Morning announcements we are now online (google slides) with the staff and teachers can do them at any time of the day that works for them and their students ... mindful minute also included each day for the class to do ... feedback has been very positive with staff
- Tutor in the Classroom working with Grade 3 and 6 as they prepare for EQAO (last week of May and first week of June)
- Renovation and Expansion Info to share plan has been revised (tentative) with gym in the middle and a multi-purpose room to the left, 7 classrooms and then additional K room at the end ... rest is the same (staff room, library, office) ... sensory room ... portables (will be outfitted with smartboards) will move over the summer (to far baseball area on the right) and construction zone will be where our tarmac is currently ... 2 portables will remain after the renovation ... new gym will have sound system and mounted projector (fundraising goal for next year) and motorized screen (board approval for that in place)
- You're the Chef run by HKCC and Healthy Muskoka District Unit (4-6 week program for Grade 4 and up) ... run here after school for this program ... training involved ... HKCC will provide supplies, etc. ... program is 1 day/week for 1-2 hours ... L. Guzzwell interested ... focus next year is nutrition for our school as well
- Marafun running program we have been part of previously ... staff have chosen to run their own program due to cost as there is no sponsorship and this is something we can run ourselves (info shared)
- French Immersion After School Program beginning next week with students identified
- After School Math Club continues weekly after school
- Tara Eskra, our Clerk Steno, has gone to Byng. We are hiring a new Clerk Steno this week (update: welcome back Tricia Vermilyea!)
- Youth Reach program funding of 250. Available to families making 50,000 or less combined ... flyer went home today with students

- Pro Grant for next year is out up to 1000. For 2017/2018 ... application is due May 25th
- School Climate Survey Data shared 89% of students care about each other, 96% have positive outlook on their future, parents feel that it is a welcoming and caring place, good school spirit, 86% students feel that they are welcomed, 92% feel there are opportunities to be involved in school activities ... bullying perspectives shared also, conflict resolution (great feedback and input coming to Admin) ... 85% students/96% parents/100% staff feel students safe at school ... student and staff wellbeing a BIG focus and positive mental health
- \$500 to parent involvement put towards 50th celebration? DONE to go towards food, etc. (Approved by Council and will be shared with Anniversary Committee)
- Ottawa trip for Grade 7/8 may be looking for support from Council \$ as we are subsidizing up to 10 students this year ... looking for other alternatives for next year and following - money from pizza and/or carnival (closer venue, smaller trip, big trip only in Grade 8, etc.)
