- **Principal's Report –**
 - Enrollment 528 – continue to have 4 full Kindergarten Classes
- **Staffing Update:** Chantal Luff – new DECE, Jaime Scicluna LTO for Jennifer Kirkpatrick, Jennifer Honeyball and Jenn Case sharing grade 6/7, Sarah Young new FSL and Jose Gough moved into a grade 1 role.
- **Construction update:**
- Troy provided a brief description of multi-purpose room/gym, larger gym with high ceilings, new change rooms and storage, 6 new classrooms and planning time office, two new entrances
- Currently using 2 entrance/exits to move students in and out from recess
- New kindergarten room at the end of the current hallway
- Side walk construction for the next few weeks
- Town did not approve Kiss and Ride and therefore new angled parking will be put into place
- Cross walk will move in the front of the school
- 5-7 weeks getting into the new gym and classrooms and all construction should be completed by Winter Break
- Summer construction was about 3 weeks behind
- New sprinkler system throughout the building – all classrooms had to be boxed and full unpacking will not occur until the extension is open and rooms are re-allocated
- New library will have staging, maintained a screen and new projector, will hold our Tech Lab and our Rover Cart, 3-D printer and chrome book lab
- Tender for the new library is out now and by January everything should be complete
- Tarmac will be laid October 4th, beach volleyball court is back in
- 5-6 portables will be removed once the new classrooms open up

- New outdoor space to include gaga ball and Frisbee golf as well as a new outdoor classroom between the new space and old
- **Halloween Howler Discussion:** - Louisa provided council with an overview of the Halloween Howler – concerns came up with regard to available space given the construction vote for whether we hold Howler or not.
 - Past Halloween funds have gone toward classroom needs, transforming learning spaces, sound system, lights and projector
 - Thought of council is that we can replace the Howler with another event – perhaps a holiday event closer to winter break
 - Motion by Heather LeQuyere to replace the Halloween Howler with Holiday ‘howler’
 - Vote: Yes (Unanimous)
